**POLICY No. 524
STUDENTS**

CORPORAL PUNISHMENT

In accordance with NRS 392.4633, the Board of Trustees of the Carson City School District decrees that corporal punishment shall not be administered upon a student in the Carson City School District. This policy does not prohibit any person from defending himself or herself if attacked by a student.

As used in this section, “corporal punishment” means the intentional infliction of physical pain upon or the physical restraint of a student for disciplinary purposes. The term does not include the use of reasonable and necessary force:

- (a) To quell a disturbance that threatens physical injury to any person or the destruction of property;
- (b) To obtain possession of a weapon or other dangerous object within a student’s control; or
- (c) For the purpose of self-defense or the defense of another person; or
- (d) To escort a disruptive student who refuses to go voluntarily with the proper authorities.
