STUDENT EDUCATION RECORDS

The Board of Trustees supports the rights of parents or guardians, and students who are 18 years of age or older to request, inspect, obtain copies, and in certain cases, amend their student's education records in accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the applicable laws of the State of Nevada.

In addition, the Board recognizes the right of Child Welfare agencies who are responsible for the supervision of case plans maintained for a child in the custody of the agency, who have developed a Memo of Understanding with the District, to request and obtain copies of education records maintained by the District.

The Carson City School District will establish administrative regulations to ensure District compliance with the legal requirements.
