PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

In order to certify the fitness of candidates and employees to discharge efficiently the duties, which they will be performing, and to protect the health of students from the transmission of communicable diseases, the Board requires the physical examination of certain personnel in accordance with state law.

The results of all required medical examinations shall be made known to the Superintendent on a confidential basis, discussed with the employee, and made a part of the employee's record. In the event of an unsatisfactory report, the Superintendent shall report the employee's disability to the Board.

Persons ill or infected with a communicable disease, which may be transmitted through food, are prohibited from working in the food handling areas of this District and such employees may be required to submit to a physical examination on request of the school nurse or District doctor.
