POLICY No. 317 CERTIFIED STAFF

ASSESSING WAGES FOR TARDINESS

It is fundamental that school programs cannot commence and pupils cannot be taught at prescribed times without the punctual and reliable attendance of members of the teaching staff. Therefore, a prerequisite for efficient performance of a teacher's professional duties is the punctual commencement and proper completion of all regularly assigned duties and such extracurricular duties as may from time to time be reasonably assigned.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to assess penalties when a teaching staff member fails to render or only partially render services for which the Board has contracted. Such penalties may include deductions from wages for time lost through tardiness.
